# Introduction

The Bachelor of Physiotherapy, or BPT, is an undergraduate program that focuses on the human body's structure.

This course lasts four years, and after the program ends, students must complete a six-month internship.

Physical forces like heat, electricity, mechanical pressure, and mechanical forces are used in physiotherapy to treat patients.

Throughout a person's life, the goal of physiotherapy is to restore maximum movement and functional ability.

Physiotherapists have a deep understanding of the human body's bones, muscles, and nerves and their intricate connections.





Physiotherapy is a branch of modern medical science which includes examination, assessment, interpretation, physical diagnosis, planning and execution of treatment and advice to any person for the purpose of preventing, correcting, alleviating and limiting dysfunction, acute and chronic bodily malfunction including life saving measures via chest physiotherapy in the intensive care unit, curing physical disorders or disability, promoting physical fitness, facilitating healing and pain relief and treatment of physical and psychological disorders through modulating psychological and physical response using physical agents, activities and devices including exercise, mobilization, manipulations, therapeutic ultrasound, electrical and thermal agents and electrotherapy for diagnosis, treatment and prevention. **(Definition as per the**

# ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA



- Candidates will need to satisfy the institutes' specific eligibility requirements.

1) Must have graduated from a reputable 10+2 program with at least 50% marks.

2) Physics, Chemistry, and Biology are required courses at the 10+2 level.

3) English proficiency is required for candidates to pass.

4) At the time of admission, candidates must be 17 years old or older.

# ADMISSION

- Before filling out the application form, candidates should ensure that they meet the required BPT eligibility criteria.
- Candidates failing to meet the prescribed conditions and requirements will be disqualified.
- The authorities prepare a merit list based on the marks obtained for the physiotherapy admission process.



# SCOPE

- Candidates who pursue BPT degree programmes have high scope in terms of career and growth opportunities.
- Physiotherapists play an important role in the health sector and therefore are required at every hospital and health clinic.
- They help in restoring the movement and function of the body in case of any injury, illness or disability.
- There are many job opportunities that a candidate will get after obtaining a degree in physiotherapy such as he or she can join any health and fitness clinic or can start a private physiotherapist clinic.
- Nowadays many multinational companies hire physiotherapists to ensure the health of their employees.
- A large number of boarding schools have started hiring physiotherapists for maintain the health of their students.



# CAREERS

- Physiotherapist is a **healthcare professional** who takes care of patients' health by offering them physical rehabilitation, and health and fitness advice.
- He or she helps in restoring a patient's disabilities for any movement and joint and muscle pain.
- **A therapy manager** is a healthcare professional who manages the day-to-day therapy services offered by the physical or occupational therapy departments.
- He or she manages the therapy sessions of the customers while making product awareness of new products.
